#### EASTERN SAN JOAQUIN GROUNDWATER AUTHORITY Board Meeting Minutes November 13, 2019

#### I. Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance & Safety Announcement/Roll Call

The Eastern San Joaquin Groundwater Authority (GWA) Board meeting was convened by Chair Chuck Winn at 11:10 A.M., on November 13, 2019, at the Robert J. Cabral Agricultural Center, 2101 E. Earhart Ave. Stockton, CA. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, a representative of the San Joaquin County Office of Emergency Services provided the required safety information.

In attendance were Chair Chuck Winn and Vice-Chair Mel Panizza; Directors Alan Nakanishi, Dan Wright, David Fletcher, Mike Henry, Eric Thorburn, John Herrick, Robert Holmes, Andy Christensen; Alternate Directors Dante Nomellini, Walt Ward, Joe Valente; and Secretary Kris Balaji.

#### II. SCHEDULED ITEMS

- A. Discussion/Action Items:
- 1. Approval of Minutes of October 17, 2019

#### Motion:

Alternate Director Walt Ward moved, and Vice-Chair Mel Panizza seconded, the approval of the October 17 minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

#### 2. GSP Adoption Process

Ms. Alyson Watson walked through the GSP adoption timeline and the GSA adoption hearing dates. Director Christensen indicated that Woodbridge Irrigation District's hearing date would be the second Thursday in December at 9:00 A.M.

# Motion:

Director Henry moved, and Director Wright seconded that the GWA recommend for GSAs to adopt the GSP. The motion passed unanimously.

# 3. Grant Update

Ms. Watson walked through updates to the grant application schedule as well as the projects selected to be included.

#### 4. Plan Implementation

# Work Items to Start in 2020:

Ms. Watson walked through work items to start in 2020. Director Henry asked a clarifying question on GSP administration. Alternate Director Nomellini suggested merging the Groundwater Authority meetings with the Advisory Water Commission meetings to promote efficiency. Director Herrick questioned how to differentiate between the GSAs implementing the GSP and the GWA. Ms. Watson clarified that the Board took action to determine what actions would be covered by the GWA and those undertaken by the GWA. Chair Winn questioned if a GSA withdrew or was unable to complete their projects, what role the GWA would have to further implement the GSP. He asked for thoughts or comments.

# Plan Administration/Manager:

Alternate Director Nomellini suggested that the County continue to serve as administrator and overall Plan Manager. He suggested that the priority should be to get all the GSAs to adopt the GSP, then get into the long term funding issues. Chair Winn noted that there are issues related to what happens if a single GSA decides that it does not want to be part of the GWA and no longer is working to implement the GSP. Would this mean the entire basin is non-compliant with state law?. Dennis Mills (Calaveras County) noted that Calaveras County's SGMA authority stops at the county boundary.

Vice-Chair Panizza noted there is uncertainty regarding GWA responsibilities post plan adoption and suggested clearly defining the GWA and County role in maintaining the GSP and coordinating the overall process for at least a year or longer. It was recommended by consensus that the County continue in its role as Plan Administrator and Manager during GSP implementation.

#### Budget through June 30, 2020:

Director Holmes indicated that the Advisory Committee recommendation is to have the Ad-Hoc Committee build a work plan, budget, and cost allocation framework to bring back to the Board in December. Ms. Watson added that the Advisory Committee recommended that the Board formally adopt the work items and budget, and that this will go to the Board in December. Mr. Zidar walked through the GWA budget approved in February 2018 and existing revenue sources, as well as the budget, costs and potential cost distribution for the last six months of the fiscal year (from January to June, 2020). Director Henry asked if the costs include the April report. Mr. Zidar responded yes.

#### Longer Term Cost Allocation:

Ms. Watson walked through preliminary proposed cost allocations and what the Ad-Hoc Committee will be recommending based on feedback from the Advisory Committee. Director Herrick asked for clarification. Ms. Watson clarified the recommendation is to look at a smaller flat fee for smaller agencies. Director Henry stated that this could be avoided if a per-AF groundwater use distribution were used.

#### 5. DWR Update

Mr. Paul Wells (DWR) stated that GSP submittal must be electronic and that DWR will work with the Plan Manager on this and will be available to help with process. He also indicated that Flood-Managed Aquifer Recharge (Flood-MAR) may be something to consider, as there are opportunities to recharge flood water. Additionally, he stated that enforcement actions are at the discretion of the State Board and hypotheticals are difficult to evaluate. Alternate Director Nomellini asked a clarifying question on a survey of groundwater basins.

#### 6. December Agenda Items

December agenda items will include Implementation Ad-Hoc Committee recommendations and GSP adoption next steps.
